FREAKY FLORAL SALAD PLATE



MATERIALS

DB35065 Pottery Salad Plate
Fan Brush
Detail Brush
Medium Brush
Liner Brush
Scissors
NCR Skull Patterns
Red Ballpoint Pen

COLORS

CMM 3 – Carnation
CMM 70 – Stardust
CMM 67 – Snowflake
CMM 18 – Pumpkin Pie
CMM 68 – Beachcomber
CMM 31 – Licorice



INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Thin down some Carnation paint by mixing in a little water. We added about 50% water to 50% paint. Sweep the fan brush in x-shaped motions all over the top of the plate. Allow the plate to dry for a few minutes.
- 2. Cut out the pattern from the sheet of NCR paper so that it's easier to center on the plate. Press firmly with a red ballpoint pen as you trace over all of the lines on the pattern. Before removing the pattern, lift a corner to ensure you've traced all the lines.
- 3. Use a medium brush to apply three generous coats of Snowflake to the skull.
- 4. Next, use a liner brush to apply three coats of Beachcomber to the small fanned flowers.
- 5. Fill in the large flowers with three generous coats of Pumpkin Pie.
- 6. Thin down some Stardust paint by mixing in a little water. We added about 50% water to 50% paint. Use a liner brush to apply one generous coat of the watered-down paint to the leaves.
- 7. Use a liner brush and the watered-down Stardust to apply lines from the center of the orange flowers.
- 8. Use a detail brush to apply two coats of Licorice to the eyes, nose, little flowers, and centers of the orange flowers.
- 9. Thin down some Licorice paint by mixing in a little water. We added about 50% water to 50% paint. Use a liner brush to apply the stems.
- 10. Finally, paint the edge and back of the plate with three generous coats of Pumpkin Pie.

TIPS

- Using a red pen to trace the pattern will help you see where you've traced.
- Three coats of paint will give a solid color.
- Regarding the colors we are adding water to, we aren't concerned about solid colors.
